As an APA-approved sponsor of continuing education, Innovation Behavioral Health Solutions, LLC is committed to the identification and resolution of potential conflicts of interest in the planning, promotion, delivery, and evaluation of continuing education. Consistent with concepts outlined in the APA Ethical Principles of Psychologists and Code of Conduct, potential conflicts of interest occur when an individual assumes a professional role in the planning, promotion, delivery, or evaluation of continuing education where personal, professional, legal, financial, or other interests could reasonably be expected to impair his or her objectivity, competence, or effectiveness.

Potential Conflicts of Interest in the Planning of Continuing Education

Dr. Sandra Leon-Villa is responsible to identify, declare, and resolve any potential conflict of interest Innovation Behavioral Health Solutions, LLC may have in offering any specific program of continuing education. In the event of a potential conflict of interest, Dr. Sandra Leon-Villa will assume responsibility to resolve the potential conflict by ensuring that:

- A. CE program providers and instructors must disclose to participants any monetary or other special interest the program provider may have with any company whose products are discussed in its CE activities. Disclosure must be made in public materials and at the beginning of the presentation itself.
- B. CE program providers must assume responsibility for taking steps to protect against and/or disclose any conflict of interest of the advisory committee, CE activity planners, course directors, and lecturer/author/instructors presenting courses. Signed conflict of interest statements must be obtained from all advisory committee members, CDE activity planners, course directors, and lecturers/authors.

Innovation Behavioral Health Solutions, LLC requires that professionals participating in the planning of continuing education identify any potential conflict of interest they may have in the review, selection, development, delivery, or evaluation of that program and disclose the conflict or recuse themselves from any decision-making concerning that program. In the event of a potential conflict of interest, Dr. Claudia Mejia and/or Dr. Sandra Leon-Villa will ensure that the individual recuses themselves from the planning process.

Potential Conflicts of Interest in the Promotion of Continuing Education

When preparing promotional material for continuing education, Innovation Behavioral Health Solutions, LLC includes information concerning any financial support, including in-kind support, provided by another party. Innovation Behavioral Health Solutions, LLC also informs potential participants of any potential conflicts of interest an instructor. If there is no financial support or any potential conflict of interest or commercial support, Innovation Behavioral Health Solutions, LLC will ensure that is clearly stated in the promotional material. If information about financial support or any potential conflict of interest is not included in the promotional material prepared for continuing education, Innovation

Behavioral Health Solutions, LLC will clearly indicate how a potential participant can secure that information.

Potential Conflicts of Interest in the Delivery of Continuing Education

Innovation Behavioral Health Solutions, LLC requires that there is a process to clearly describe any financial support for a continuing education program at the time the continuing education program begins. Any other relationship that could be reasonably construed as a conflict of interest will also be disclosed. If there is no financial support or potential conflict of interest, Innovation Behavioral Health Solutions, LLC will ensure there is a process (e.g., a designated individual or a slide at the start of the presentation, documentation in materials) to clearly state any potential conflicts at the time the continuing education program begins.
